Otsego County is seeking bids for a 2014 Ford Utility Interceptor for its Sheriff's Office. All bids are to be based on the following minimum equipment standards:

Vehicle requirements:

2014 Ford Utility Interceptor All wheel Drive

Interceptor Optional features:

43D – Dark car Feature- Courtesy lamp disable when any door is opened

17T – Dome Lamp- Red/White light in cargo area

60A – Pre- wiring for grille lamp, siren and speaker

51Z – spot lamp dual

60R – Noise suppression bonds

68G – rear door handles inoperable/ locks inoperable

18W – Windows- rear window power delete, operable from front drivers side switches

86P – Front headlamp/ Police Interceptor housing only

47C- Police wire harness Connector kit – front

These are all the factory direct requirements including additional features.

Bids are **due by Friday, October 4 at noon** local time. Bids must be sealed and have Bid 2013-06 marked on the exterior. Bids can be mailed/dropped off at 225 W. Main Street, Room 2013, Gaylord, MI 49735. There will be a public bid opening on Friday, October 4 at 1:00 pm at 225 W. Main Street in Room 212.
