

## PUBLIC NOTICE

### POLITICAL SIGNS

As the upcoming political campaigns begin, political signs will once again adorn our countryside as well as our roads. In order to uniformly treat the removal of these signs as well as other temporary signs in the County right-of-way, the following guidelines will be followed by Road Commission Personnel:

1. Remove all temporary signs placed within County Road right-of-way that are within 33' of the center line of the road.
2. Remove all temporary signs that interfere with sight distance at intersections and commercial driveways.
3. Store all removed signs at our maintenance garage for at least 14 days.
4. All temporary political signs remaining within the right-of-way more than 7 days after the election are to be removed.

It remains the responsibility of the person placing the sign to obtain any necessary prior approval from the owner of the abutting property.
