**VANDERBILT AREA SCHOOLS
 MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL
 BUILDING AND SITE
 SINKING FUND TAX LEVY**

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy building and site sinking fund millage previously approved by the electors.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Vanderbilt Area Schools, Otsego, Charlevoix and Cheboygan Counties, Michigan, be increased by and the Board of education be authorized to levy not to exceed .75 mill (\$.75 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 4 years, 2017 to 2020, inclusive, to continue to provide for a sinking fund for the construction or repair of school buildings and all other purposes authorized by law; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2017 is approximately \$70,000.
