Shall the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution on the amount of ad valorem taxes which may be levied by the County of Ossego, State of Michigan, against taxable property in the County be increased by up to one-quarter (1/4) of one mill (\$.25 per \$1,000 of taxable value) on the taxable value of such property for a period of five (5) years, 2017 through 2021, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for the continued operation and maintenance of all programs, parks and facilities under the jurisdiction of the Ossego County Parks and Recreation Commission, including the Community Center, and shall the Ossego County Board of Commissioners be authorized to levy such millage for these purposes?
