Otsego County is seeking bids for **two (2) 2019 Ford Utility Interceptors** for its Sheriff's Office. All bids are to be based on the following minimum equipment standards:

Vehicle Requirements:

(2) Two 2019 Ford Utility Interceptors All Wheel Drive, **3.5L V6 Eco Boost Engine**

The color of the vehicles will be Sterling Grey Metallic- Order Code-TN

Interceptor Optional features:

86P – Front headlamp/ Police Interceptor housing only

86T – Tail lamp/ Police interceptor Housing Only

43D – Dark car Feature- Courtesy lamp disable when any door is opened

43L - Police Silent Mode

51Z – Spotlight Dual (driver and passenger) Incandescent Bulbs

68G – Rear door handles inoperable/ locks inoperable

18D – Global Lock/Unlock Feature

18W – Windows- rear window power delete, operable from front drivers side switches

549 – Mirrors – Heated side view

76R – Reverse Sensing

60R – Noise suppression bonds

47A - Police Engine Idle feature

595 – Remote Keyless Entry w/2 key fobs, plus 2x key fobs. Total 4 fobs already programmed

59B – Keyed Alike – 1284x

These are all the factory direct requirements including additional features.

The Sheriff's Department expects delivery of both vehicles to be in January 2019.
