

Membership Requirements include:

- Must be a United States citizen.
- Must be a resident of Otsego County or any surrounding county without an organized Mounted Division.
- Must be 18 years of age.
- Must have a valid Michigan driver's license or valid Michigan id. card.
- Must be of good character and reputation (as determined by passing the Otsego County Sheriff's Department back ground investigation).
- Must pay annual dues
- Must agree to maintain current CPR and First Aid certification.
- Must attain/maintain certification for self and equine (if applicable), saddle, tack and transportation.
- Must attend search & rescue related training
- Must conform to the policies and procedures of the Otsego County Sheriff's Department.
- Must attend or participate in one-third of the regular scheduled events.
- Must attend seventy-five percent of regular scheduled meetings and must not miss more than two consecutive meetings.
