REGULAR MEETING
December 2nd, 2019

The Vanderbilt Village Council held its regular mtg. on Monday, December 2nd, 2019 at the Village Hall. The Council was called to order by President Sayles at 7 p.m. and was opened with the Lord's Prayer followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Comment: Discussed community concerns relating to dog ordinance & enforcement issues. Request was made to the county admin. to admin. their rules to allow enforcement of rules in Villages having 3000 or less residents. It is understood this adjustment would open enforcement rules through OTC. We are waiting for a response.
