<b>United States Senator</b> Vote for not more than 1	<b>United States Senator</b> Vote for not more than 1	<p>Shall Johannesburg-Lewiston Area Schools, Otsego, Montmorency and Oscoda Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Twenty-One Million Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$21,900,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, in one or more series, for the purpose of:</p> <p>remodeling, furnishing and refurbishing, and equipping and re-equipping school buildings; erecting and equipping a new storage building; purchasing school buses; acquiring and installing instructional technology in school buildings; preparing, developing, improving, and equipping athletic fields and sites; and erecting, furnishing, and equipping a new performing arts center, fitness center, and fieldhouse addition to the High School?</p> <p>The following is for informational purposes only:</p> <p>The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2021 is 2.99 mills (\$2.99 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation). The maximum number of years the bonds of any series may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is twenty-five (25) years. The estimated single average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is 2.69 mills (\$2.69 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation).</p> <p>The school district does not expect to borrow from the State to pay debt service on the bonds and the total amount of qualified bonds currently outstanding is \$-0-. The total amount of qualified loans currently outstanding is \$-0-.
