

**VILLAGE COUNCIL MINUTES
REGULAR MEETING
January 6th, 2020**

The Vanderbilt Village Council held its regular mtg. on Monday, January 6th, 2020 at the Village Hall. The Council was called to order by President Sayles at 7 p.m. and was opened with the Lord's Prayer followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Commissioners Report – Budget line items approved by governor; the county's budget is back in balance. Teamsters budgets have both been approved. Bus accident had occurred and will be repaired not replaced. Cost of repair will be approx. \$46k. Bryce Industries will be providing overview and helping to form committees to inform the citizens of the needs for a new jail installation.

Presidents Report – Still are looking for a citizen of Vanderbilt to become a member of the fireboard. We are still in need of a student to participate with the planning committee. Books and keys have still not been returned by previous council member and planning committee member. President Sayles will follow up on these items.

Clerk – Discussion with the township relating to maintenance of the trailhead park/pavilion. The Village will help with the clearing of snow to allow access to the restrooms. Yearend dates were provided to board (budget workshop, budget request deadlines, public hearing and settlement night). Dates were approved by council.

Street Administrators – n/a

Public Comment: J. Robinson discussed concerns about falling limbs due to weather and offered his assistance if the Village needed help.
