In the **1960's** our terminal was very minimalistic but already started reflecting in its design the local communities newly incorporated Alpine Village theme. Torn down in 2006 to make space for new terminal.



In the **1970's** the terminal received a two story addition to the existing building pictured above. This allowed for more space and included an elevated lookout for the duty UNICOM operator, torn down in 2006. We still have a set of its iconic window shutters on display.



In **2006** the terminal we have today was built. It is filled with the very latest in technology and comfort. With two equipped conference rooms, reception counter, pilot lounge, game room, coffee bar and spacious lobby, meeting all aircraft needs
